According to a recent survey, 62% of the United States population own an American flag. 45% of the people that own a flag display it daily, while only 32% fly the flag on designated holidays.

SLIDE 9:

Units can really "SHINE" by hosting flag awareness programs and participating in patriotic holiday events. A list of patriotic holidays and special dates is listed in your Plan of Action.

SLIDE 10:

We should always encourage Auxiliary members to support the flag amendment to protect the United States flag from desecration. Members should contact their federal and state representatives, asking them to support the flag amendment.

The theme for this year's Americanism Essay Contest is a question that young people will be eager to answer...... CLICK 1 "What Does Freedom Mean to My Family?" CLICK 1 This contest is open to students from grades 3-12. CLICK 1 Grade levels are divided into 5 classes. CLICK 1 There will be one award for each class per division. When contacting students about the contest, don't limit your search to schools. Remember local youth groups such as the Boy and Girl Scouts and always encourage Junior Auxiliary members to participate. Rules and cover sheets can be found in your Plan of Action.
