Financial Info:

All quotas-rehabilitation, education, Girl State and sock – must be paid to Department by January 31, 2015. To qualify for an over-quota delegate, your unit must be 100%in membership by January 31, 2015.

- 1. Registration fee for 2015 is 300.00 per delegate (this includes two (2) polo shirts per delegate)
- 2. Transportation expenses are determined by the District Chairman.
- 3. Spending money is determined by the Unit.

02/01/2015 Completed registration form and registration fee (300.00 per delegate) must be received at Dept. Headquarters. Check made out to American Legion Auxiliary Department of Florida.

Do not interview and/or select delegates until you have your online Application in hand. When your Unit is mailed their Online Application the new card will be 5.5" by 4.25 card, with instructions for the selected girls to complete an online application, will be mailed to your unit. The card will include the website address, a unique user name and password for each approved delegate and alternate selected for your unit. Girls will then complete their application online. Once the online application is complete, an email will be sent to Department and forwarded to the Unit so they are aware that the application has been completed. There will be no paper applications. You will receive only an instruction card for each girl to complete the online application.

03/12/2015 Delegates and alternates completed applications are due to Department Headquarters. Please make sure you stay in contact with your delegates. Call delegates and alternates to check their status, please make sure your delegates and alternates go to an orientation in your District or in or in another District if they can't make the one in your area.

Make sure your delegates haven't changed their minds.
