Office: President and Vice President (currently in her third year as Unit Vice President)


Committee Chairmanships (since joining the Auxiliary): Constitution and bylaws and Membership Chairman

In addition to these positions Shelby has been active in various unit programs for Children and Youth, Veteran Rehabilitation, and Family Support.


