Janice has been a member of the American Legion Auxiliary since 2014.




- By invitation, the Coast Guard Luncheon in January 2018

At the District Level, Janice has served as Community Service chairman for District 16 from 2019-2022.


At the National Level, Janice is currently serving on the Education Committee.
