

Florida Girls State Positions

City Advisors: Applicants must be at least 19 years of age and in reasonably good health. City Advisors are responsible for supervising approximately 30 delegates throughout the program. This role requires the ability to actively engage with participants, provide guidance and support, and ensure their safety and well-being during their stay.

Assistance City Advisors: Applicant will work alongside City Advisors to support the day-to-day operations of Girls State. They will assist with supervising delegates, helping with daily activities, providing guidance and encouragement, and ensuring the delegates have a positive, safe, and successful experience throughout the program.

Medical Staff: Applicant must hold, at a minimum, a current EMT certification. Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs), Registered Nurses (RNs), Physicians Assistants (Pas), Nurse Practitioners (NPs) and Physicians are also encouraged to apply. Medical Staff is responsible for providing basic medical care and responding to emergencies should they arise. Most medical need during Girls State involve minor issues. The Medical Staff member should be prepared to assess situations, provide appropriate care within their scope of practice, and determine when additional medical attention is necessary.

Support Staff: Applicant play an important role in the success of Girls State by assisting wherever needed throughout the program. Responsibilities may include helping with check in, check out, activities, providing general assistance to staff and delegates. Applicants should be flexible, dependable and willing to step in wherever support is needed to help ensure a safe, organized, and successful Girls State experience. Position can be part time.

All applicants must pass background checks and fingerprinting.
