Under President Robin's theme this year, the Juniors are the FOOTSTEPS.




#### Mission-related:

### Leadership:

- Allow Junior members to shadow senior member officers at meetings and allow Junior members to hold appropriate offices at the Unit and District levels. *Involve* them in posting colors at meetings and other Auxiliary events Allow Juniors to lead opening ceremonies (the Pledge, prayer, Preamble, etc.) Promote ALA Scholarships to high school Juniors, including the Member Loyalty scholarship, to encourage remaining a member after turning 18
- *Encourage* Juniors to attend Girls State the summer between Junior and Senior years of high school

- Give your Junior members a voice; allow them to participate
- Plan mission-related activities that will interest and inspire Juniors •Hold graduation ceremonies for Juniors who are moving to Senior membership status and pay the first year of senior membership dues to encourage them to remain a member
- •Share information about the ALA scholarships available at both the Department and National levels
- Pair older Junior members with younger members to promote mentorship

### Promote the Junior Member of the Year award


- Five divisional awards, one National JMOY will be awarded

- Department Junior Member of the Year

    - Awarded to the Florida American Legion Auxiliary Junior Member who is a current paid member in good standing who shows outstanding participation in one or more programs of the American Legion Auxiliary. The Narrative must be typed, submitted, and signed by the Unit Junior Activities Chairman (or a nominating senior member) not

exceeding 500 words. A cover page must include the nominee's name, age, date of birth, Unit name and number, Jr's ALA membership number, e-mail, mailing address, and contact #. The narrative should summarize and include the Junior's accomplishments during the current year. Pictures, clippings, social media posts, scrapbooks, folders, flyers, etc., can be included and are not counted against the word count. The submission must be signed by the Unit President. Entries to be received by the Department Junior Activities chairman: postmarked before May 1, 2026, and the winner will be presented with a plaque at the Department Convention.
