WHEN TO FLY THE FLAG

The flag should be displayed, from sunrise to sunset, on all days when the weather permits, but especially on:

*New Year's Day, January 1st.

Inauguration Day, January 20th (or January 21st if 20th falls on Sunday)

*Martin Luther King's Birthday, Third Monday in January.

Lincoln's Birthday, February 12th.

*President's Day, third Monday in February

Washington's Birthday, February 22nd.

Easter Sunday.

Mother's Day, Second Sunday in May.

Armed Forces Day, Third Saturday in May.

*Memorial Day (half-staff until noon), Last Monday in May.

Flag Day, June 14th.

*Juneteenth, June 19th.

*Independence Day, July 4th.

*Labor Day, First Monday in September.

Constitution Day, September 17th.

*Columbus Day, October 12th.

Navy Day, October 27th.

*Veterans Day, November 11th.

*Thanksgiving Day, Fourth Thursday in November.

*Christmas Day, December 25th.

Election Days (various).

Additional days may be proclaimed by the President of the United States. Any declared State and Local Holidays.

*Please be aware, the eleven federally observed dates of the above holidays may be different from the actual dates. (i.e.: when a federal holiday falls on the weekend, it will be observed the day before if it falls on Saturday or after if on Sunday)
